## When do you need to wear cut resistant gloves?

- Deburring
- Lifting robot
- Lifting wood
- Lifting metal
- Working with/handling anything sharp

# Where can cut resistant gloves be found?

By or on the safety stand, on the robot carts or in the safety glasses tubes.

# What other PPE do you need when working with sharp objects?

Safety glasses, closed toed shoes, no shorts.

# If you are using equipment that is sharp what are the requirements?

You must have been trained to do so by a mentor approved to train you. A mentor should be in the room/and or supervising, and the table saw can never be used without mentor supervision.

# When working with a knife in what direction should you cut?

Always cut away from your body in a way that the knife is unlikely to cut you.

# Because something is deburred can you assume that it is not sharp?

No! Always use cation with things that could be sharp, and don't use your fingers to test it out!

# Always use cation when working with sharp objects and help others do the same!
